## Concert Band and String Orchestra Classes

- Wind Ensemble (top concert band)
- Wind Symphony (2<sup>nd</sup> concert band)
- String Orchestra (dependent upon enrollment, may be split into 2 groups)

### Year Long Electives

The concert bands and string orchestra are one year elective classes that meet during the regular school day. Students in these ensembles perform several times throughout the year in the evenings, and there are sometimes weekend events. All students will “audition” for these classes during the second week of February. The intention of the audition is to get to know each freshman and identify the appropriate class placement for them.

***Any student can participate in a concert band or orchestra class regardless of experience.***

## Color Guard

### *Year long Fine Arts Elective*

Any student interested in being a member of our Color Guard and learning the art of flags, rifles, and sabres, can join our Color Guard. All students enrolled in this class must also be in the Marching Band.

## Jazz Ensembles

- Jazz A – Year long elective before and after school (0 period)
- Jazz B - Year long elective before school (0 Period)
- Jazz C – Spring Semester Only, after school (7<sup>th</sup> Period)

Participation in the Jazz Bands are by **audition only** during the last week of May. Each jazz band rehearses either before or after school and times vary. Rehearsal times for the 2011-2012 school year will be posted in May prior to auditions. If you are interested in playing in the jazz band, please register for “Jazz Ensemble” during your registration period. We will post audition music and times in early May, and your schedule will then be adjusted according to your placement.

## Marching Band

### ***First Semester Elective – After School (7<sup>th</sup> Period)***

### ***One Semester PE Credit***

The Marching Band is one of the most active, character building, FUN, competitive, inspiring classes at Moorpark High! The marching band begins rehearsals during band camp in August. They rehearse approximately 8-10 hours per week after school, performs at all home football games (and some away), community parades/events, and competes in field show competitions across the state. Note: “Marching Band” consists of woodwinds, brass, drumline, pit, and Color Guard.

**Corequisite: Students in Marching Band, MUST also be enrolled in Color Guard, Wind Ensemble, Wind Symphony or String Orchestra class.**
